

## Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview 01 – 05 November 2021)

### BORDER MONITORING

Situation kept worsening in the major BCPs on Corridor X. Horgos/Roszke hit new record high on SRB-HUN direction with trucks idling up to 12h but was labelled stable because of significant improvement on HUN-SRB. Batrovci/Bajakovo and Gradina/Kalotina went worse on both sides, with record highs being reached on SRB-EU direction. Waiting times were decreasing in Gradiska/Stara Gradiska but increased again in Vatin/ Stamora Moravita. The other BCPs under monitoring remained mostly stable.

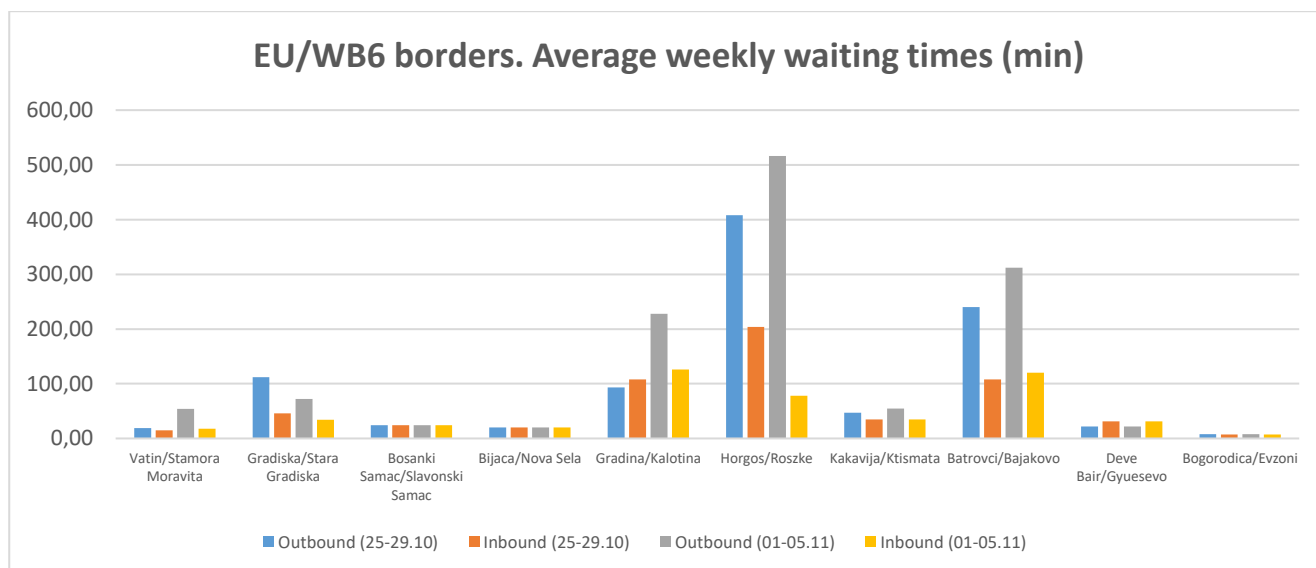


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
