

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview 15 – 19 November 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

Situation was mostly improving throughout the region. After past weeks' record highs, waiting times were low in Horgos/Roszke on SRB-HUN direction. Overall situation improved also in Batrovci/Bajakovo though waiting times on HR-SRB direction increased. Gradina/Kalotina finally turned better, but idle times remained nevertheless high on both directions. Waiting times were also decreasing in Gradiska/Stara Gradiska and Vatin/Stamora Moravita but increased in Kakavija/Ktismata (on ALB-EL direction). The other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.

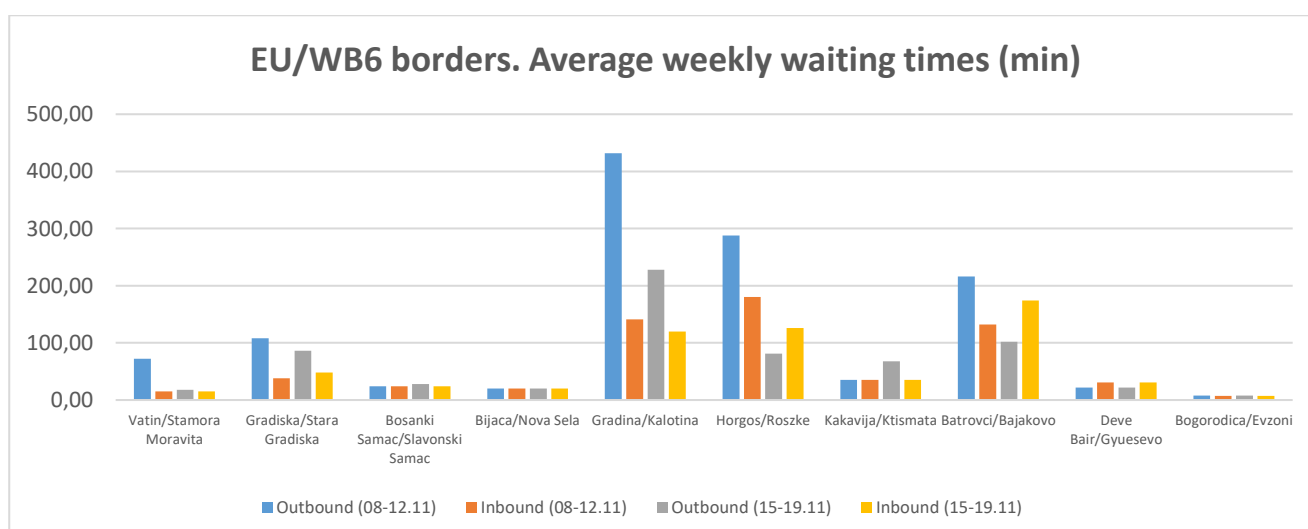


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
