

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders

Weekly overview 22 – 26 November 2021

BORDER MONITORING

Waiting times almost doubled in Horgos/Roszke on SRB-HUN direction but slightly decreased on the opposite side of the border. Despite slight improving on HR-SRB direction, Batrovci/Bajakovo also turned worse because of the significant increase on the SRB side of the border. Gradina/Kalotina kept improving, despite an increase in waiting times from BG. Vatin/Stamora Moravita also turned worse on SRB-RO direction while the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
