

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview 06 – 10 December 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

Horgos/Roszke improved on both directions, most significantly on SRB-HUN. Batrovci/Bajakovo went also better, but waiting times remained nevertheless high making it the busiest BCP in the region for yet another week. Gradina/Kalotina turned (much) worse on SRB-BG direction while improving on the other side of the border. Vatin/Stamora Moravita and Gradiska/Stara Gradiska went better while slight worsening was registered in Kakavija/Ktismata and Bosanski Samac/Slavonski Samac. All the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.

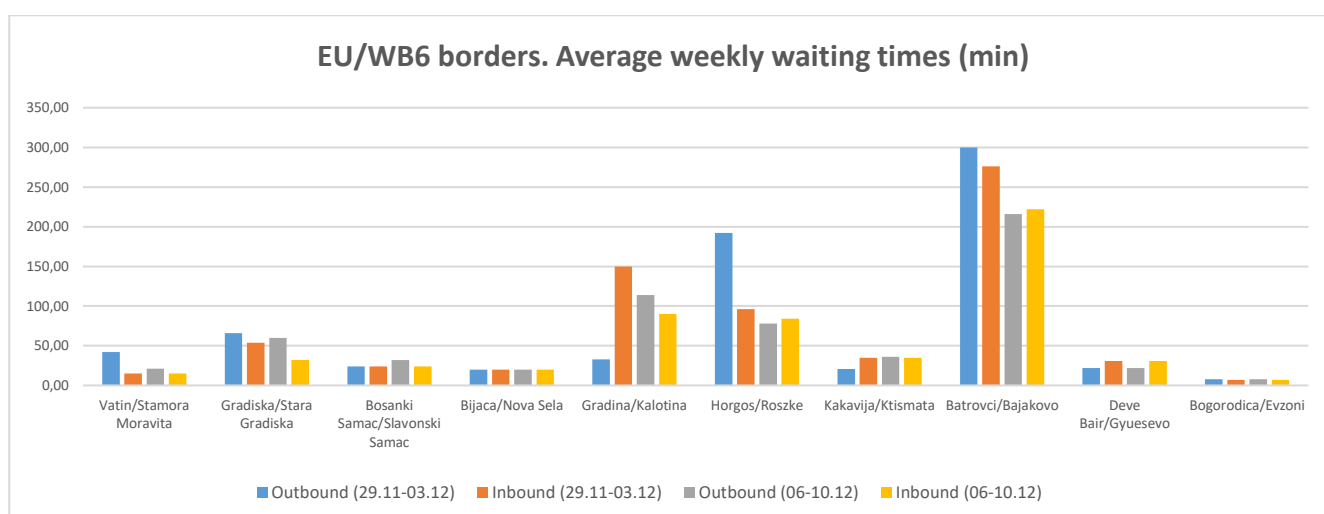


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
