

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders

Weekly overview 13 – 17 December 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

Both Horgos/Roszke and Batrovci/Bajakovo turned worse with the latter experiencing the longest weekly waiting times in both directions since the beginning of the monitoring exercise. Gradina/Kalotina remained mostly stable with slight variations on both directions as compared with the previous week. Vatin/Stamora Moravita and Gradiska/Stara Gradiska went also worse the only (slight) improvement from previous week being registered in Bosanski Samac/Slavonski Samac. The other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
