

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders

Weekly overview 20 – 24 December 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

The last week before Christmas brought improvements on both directions in Horgos/Roszke and Batrovci/Bajakovo, the most significant time savings being registered on the SRB-EU direction. Gradina/Kalotina turned worse in both directions with waiting times towards Bulgaria almost doubling. Same happened in Kakavija/Ktismata, while Vatin/Stamora Moravita experienced slight improvement from previous week. The other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
