

## Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview 29 November – 03 December 2021)

### BORDER MONITORING

Horgos/Roszke kept worsening on SRB-HUN direction while waiting times decreased slightly on the opposite side of the border. Waiting times in Batrovci/Bajakovo almost doubled on both sides of the border making it one of the busiest weeks all-time. Idle times plummeted in Gradina/Kalotina on SRB-BG direction coming close to the minimum recorded. Vatin/Stamora Moravita, Gradiska/Stara Gradiska and Kakavija/Ktismata also turned better while the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.

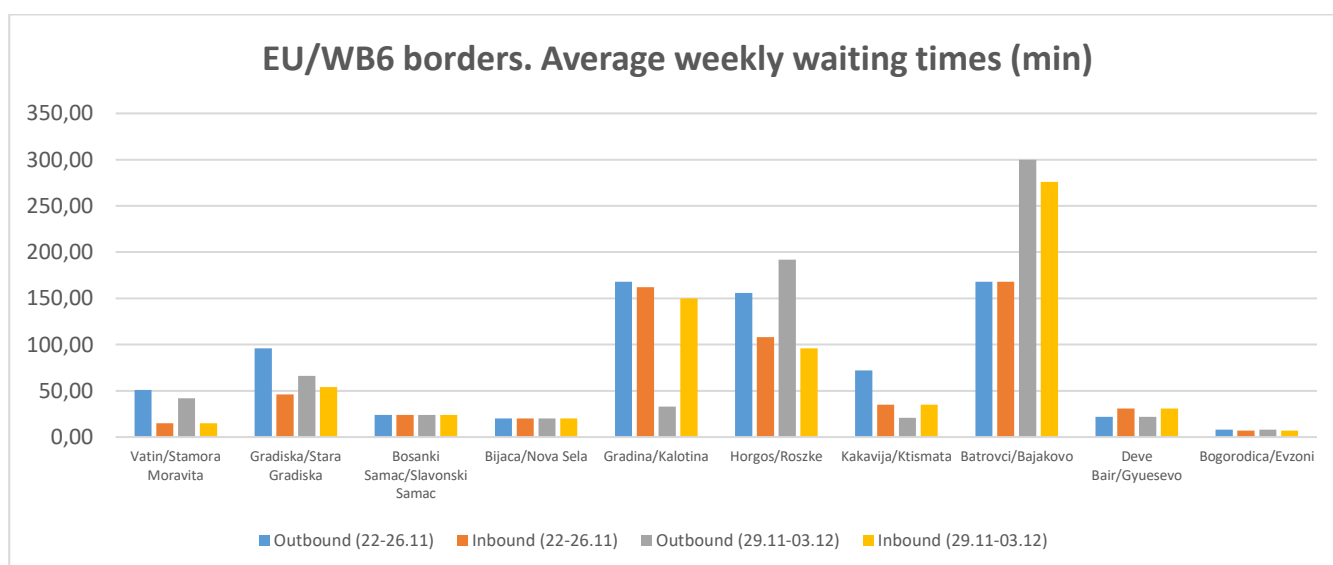


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
