

## Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (17 – 21 January 2022)

### BORDER MONITORING

Horgos/Roszke and Batrovci/Bajakovo improved significantly on the SRB-EU direction. On the opposite side, waiting times remained stable or marginally grew (in Horgos/Roszke). Gradina/Kalotina went worse on SRB-BG direction while remaining stable on the opposite side. Situation improved in Gradiska/Stara Gradiska (on BiH-HR direction) while the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.

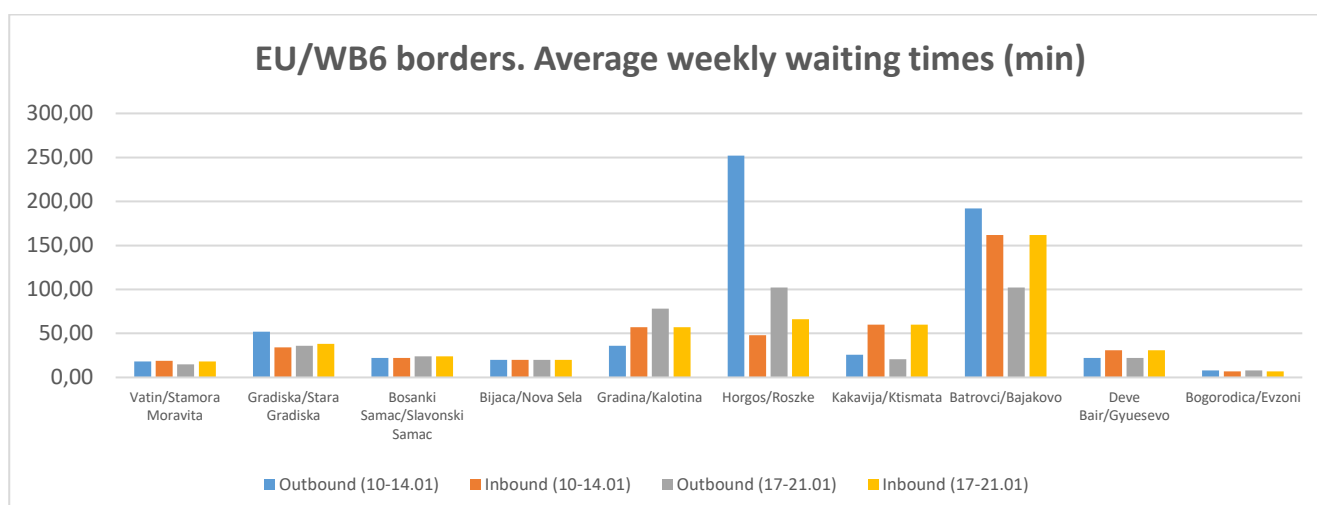


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
