BORDER MONITORING

The holiday pace continued in the first week of 2022 (which included also the Orthodox Christmas celebration). There was still limited room for improvements in Horgos/Roszke, Batrovci/Bajakovo, Gradiska/Stara Gradiska and Gradina/Kalotina. However, the latter was again experiencing waiting times in excess of 1 hour on the BG-SRB direction. Kakavija/Ktismata was going against the trend, being the only BCP in the region where waiting times were on the rise (around 1 h on both directions). The other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
