Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (10 – 14 January 2022)

BORDER MONITORING

Unsurprisingly, the first week following winter break brought increased border waiting times all over the region. The only improvement was recorded in Kakavija/Ktismata, which kept going against the trend. In Horgos/Roszke and Batrovci/Bajakovo waiting times increase was sharp (more prominent on SRB-EU direction), while Gradina/Kalotina remained rather stable. Increased waiting times were also recorded in Gradiska/Stara Gradiska and Vatin/Stamora Moravita while the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
