

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (07 – 11 February 2022)

BORDER MONITORING

Waiting times increased in Horgos/Roszke, more significantly on SRB-HUN direction. Batrovci/Bajakovo was marked as stable but experienced, nevertheless significant variations compared with last week (SRB-HR direction got worse, while HR-SRB direction improved). Gradina/Kalotina kept improving, with waiting times on SRB-BG direction coming close to minimum. Kakavija/Ktismata, Bosanski Samac/Slavonski Samac and Gradiska/Stara Gradiska also got better, while slight worsening was recorded in Vatin Stamora Moravita. The other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.

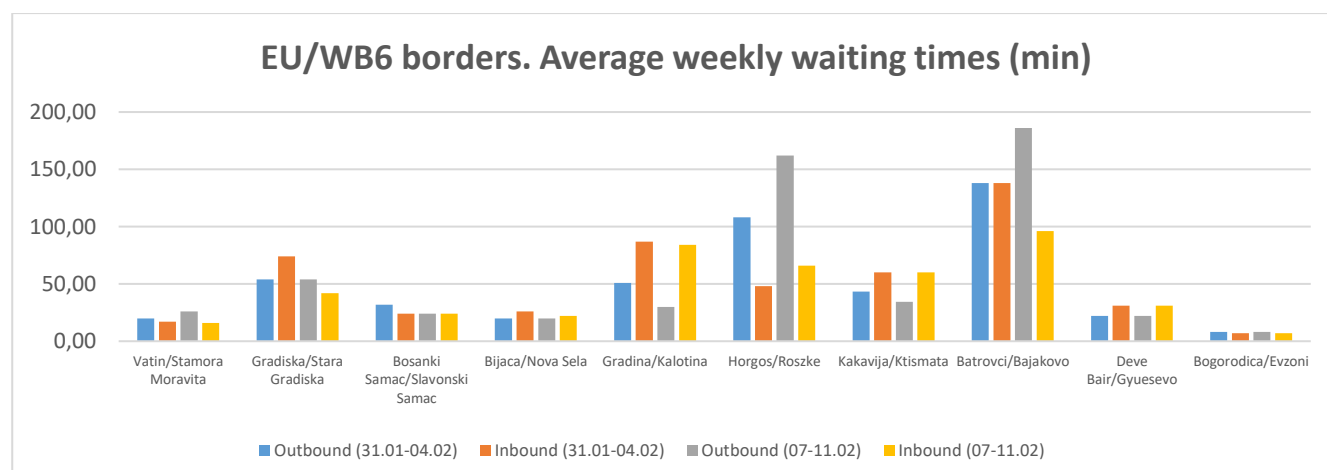


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
