

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (14 – 18 February 2022)

BORDER MONITORING

Horgos/Roszke remained basically stable, with small variations only occurring in both directions. Batrovci/Bajakovo improved slightly on both sides of the border. Waiting times remained low in Gradina/Kalotina on SRB-BG direction but increased significantly on the other side of the border. Kakavija/Ktismata and Gradiska/Stara Gradiska went also worse while the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.

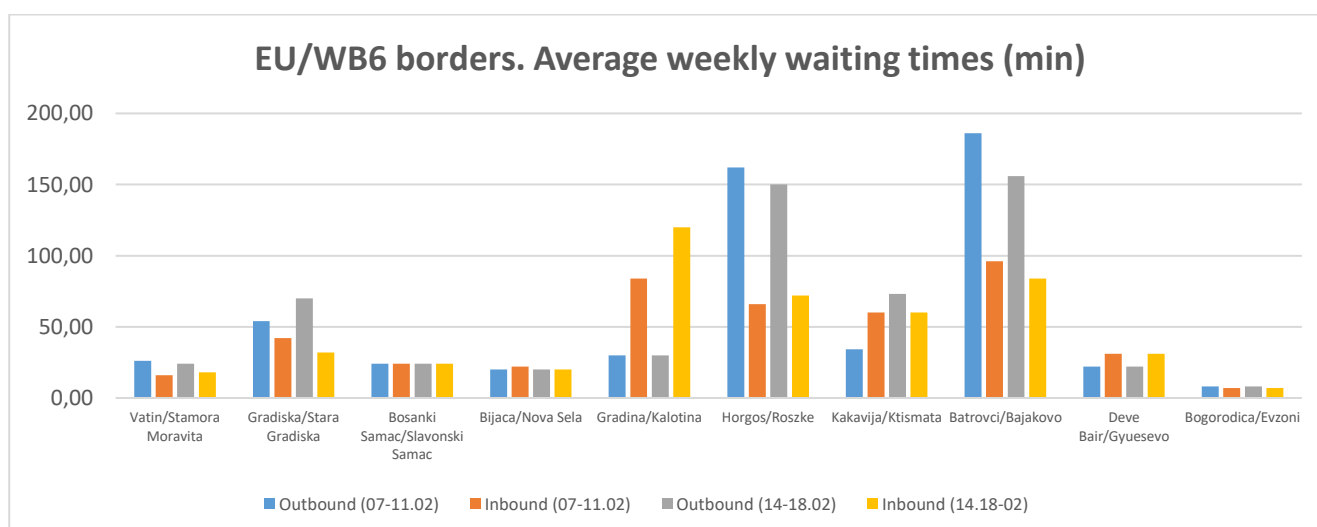


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
