

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (24 – 28 January 2022)

BORDER MONITORING

All major BCPs on Corridor X turned worse. Waiting times increased significantly on SRB-EU direction in Horgos/Roszke and Batrovci/Bajakovo while slightly decreasing on the opposite side. In Gradina/Kalotina waiting times increased in both directions. All the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.

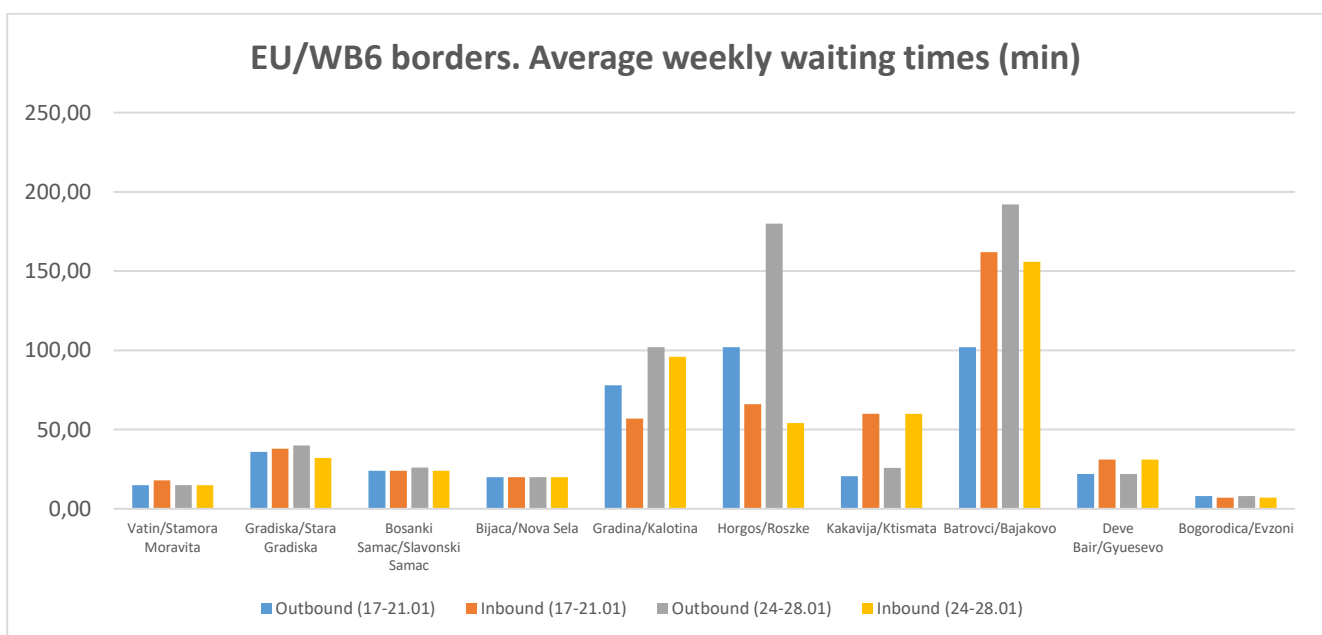


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
