

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (31 January – 04 February 2022)

BORDER MONITORING

Unlike last week, all major BCPs on Corridor X (Horgos/Roszke, Batrovci/Bajakovo and Gradina/Kalotina) turned better. Improvement was more significant on SRB-EU direction, but waiting times decreased also for traffic entering the region. On the other side, there were slight increases in idling time at BiH-HR border and in Vatin/Stamora Moravita. All the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.

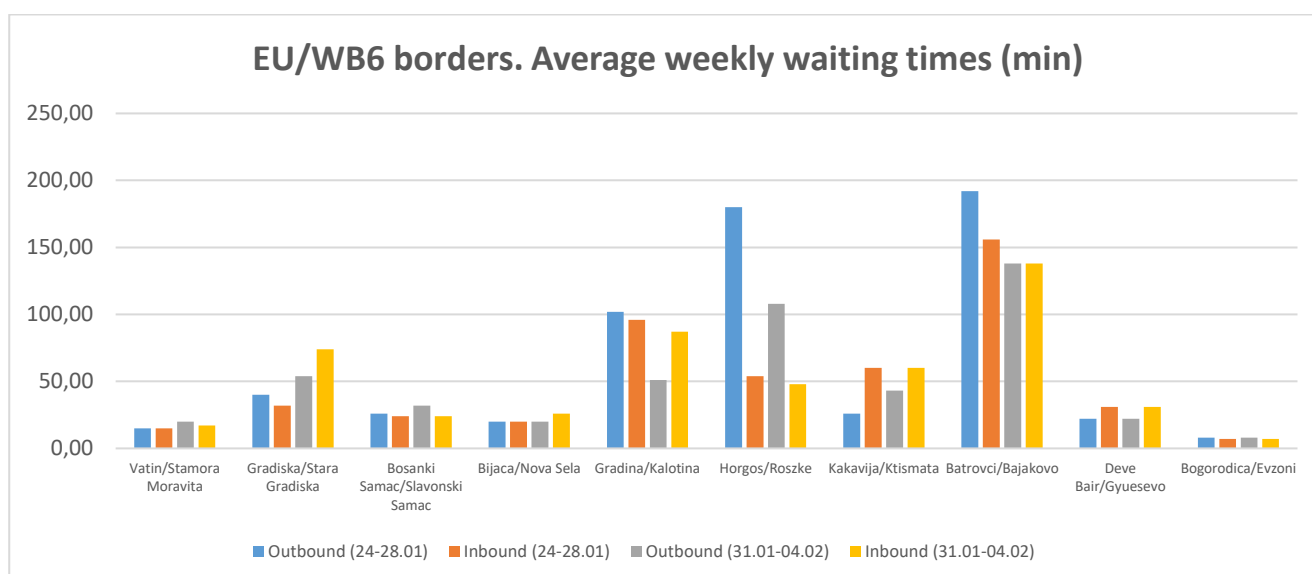


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
