- Under the Treaty establishing the Transport Community, the South East European Parties have committed to ensure the development of the indicative extension of the TEN-T comprehensive and core networks to the Western Balkans, in view of their commitment to progressively integrate their transport markets with the European Union's, based on the relevant acquis.
- The objective of this assignment is delivering a comprehensive overview of the transportation needs, traffic flows, and market situation on the Western Balkans by assessment of the capacities, economic and technical level of development of freight and passenger transport in the region, and thus fulfilling the obligations derived from the Transport Community Treaty signed by South East European Parties, related to Annex 1 of the Treaty, the Rail Action Plan.

- WB6 RMMS report based on collected data

- Update of technical parameters and charges for presentation of core corridor rail freight facilities

### **Ongoing activities:**


 Market surveys through interviews with railway undertakings and intermodal operators, logistic service providers and shippers

## 6. Need for the support of the members of TC for Railways



- ✓ To the best of our knowledge the following feasibility studies have been prepared or are in preparation by WBIF:
  - 1. Albania: 2 recent studies completed and approved. One for Durres-Montenegro (IPF7) and one for Durress-Rroghozina (IPF8). From Rroghozina to NMK (Corridor VII) exists the study of IPF4.
  - 2. Serbia: 3 recent and ongoing studies. One for IPF9 for Belgrade to Sid- border with Croatia. Then PPF9 study for Nis-Belgrade and IPF8 study Nis-Presevo.
  - 3. Kosovo: 2 studies by IPF2 which are updated with new FS for the line north south from Serbia into Pristina and from Pristina to Nis. The new studies are probably done by IPF6 or IPF7, and possibly by EBRD (for the section from Ibar to Pristina which is under construction.
  - 4. NMK: The latest FS for Corridor VIII is by TYPSA and provides forecasts for the connection all along the line and especially from Skopje to Albania. But recently (one of IPFs) completed a study for the ERTMS. Maybe there is info there. I am sure the Ministry in Skopje can provide the data, from previous studies. In IPF4 study for Presevo-Tabanovce joint RW station there is info for the traffic forecast to/from Serbia and for transit traffic.
  - 5. MNE: We are not aware of FS. But there is a study by an IPF about the FS of the highway Bar-Boljare. Maybe there is info there for the railway, as competition.
  - 6. BIH: We are not aware of any recent study in WBIF.
