



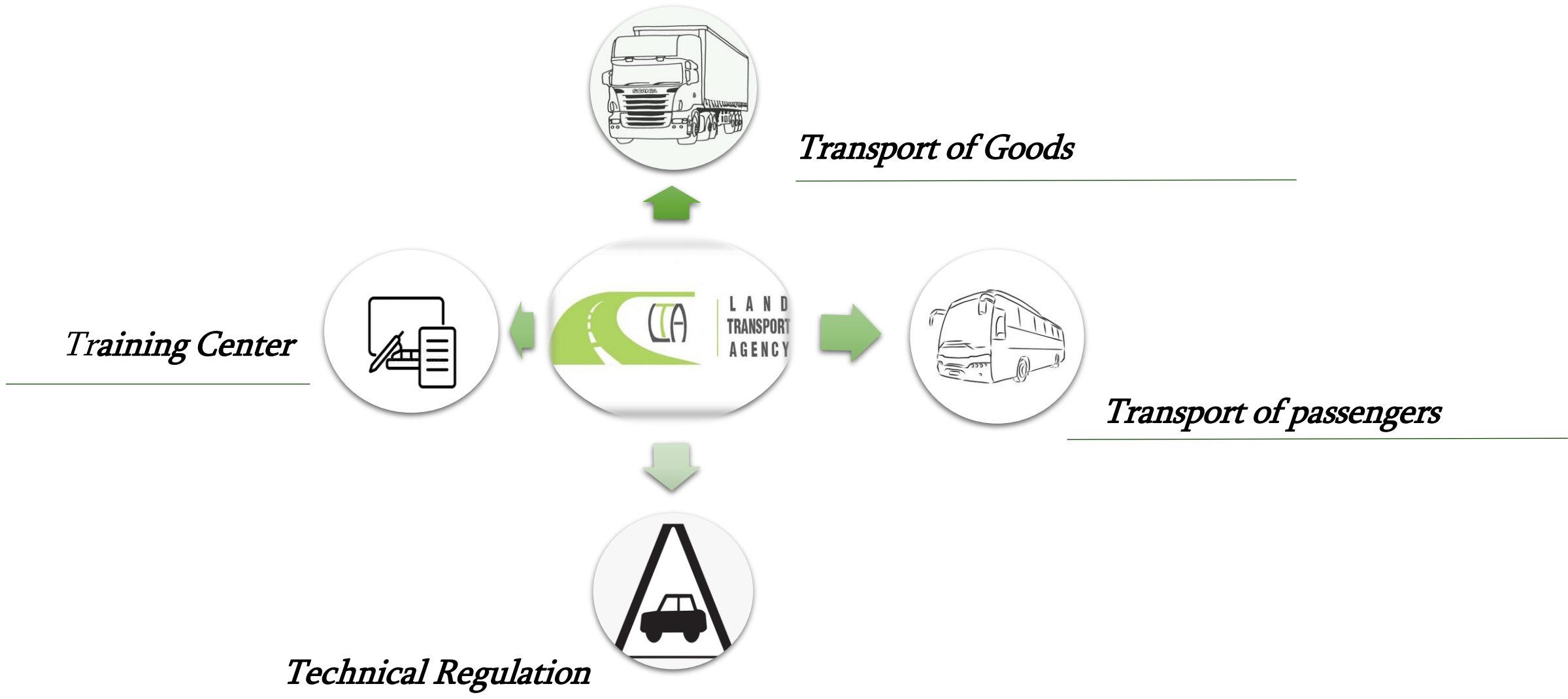

Main activities of LTA



Approximation with the EU Legislation



Mostly Implemented:

1. **Directive 96/53/EC** on the maximum authorized dimensions and weights for road vehicles
2. **Directive 96/6/EEC** on the installation and use of speed limitation devices
3. **Directive 2003/59/EC** on the initial qualification and periodic training of drivers
4. **Directive 2008/68/EC** on the inland transport of dangerous goods
5. **Directive 2009/40/EC** on roadworthiness tests

Under Implementation:

1. **Regulation (1071/2009 EC)** establishing common rules concerning the conditions to be complied with to pursue the occupation of road transport operator
2. **Regulation (EC) 561/2006, Regulation (EEC) 3821/85, Directive 2006/22 EC** concerning social legislation relating to road transport
3. **Directive 2002/15/EC** on the organization of the working time of persons performing mobile road transport activities



Approximation with the EU Legislation

Directive 2008/68/EC on the inland transport of dangerous goods

- ❑ The Parliament of Georgia ratified the **ADR Agreement** in 2016.
- ❑ By The Technical Regulation №89 “on the Carriage of Dangerous Goods” ADR is implemented into the Georgian legislation.
- ❑ UNECE has recognized the ADR Driver’s Certificate published by the LEPL Land Transport Agency.
- ❑ ADR 2023 is officially translated into Georgian and published on LTA webpage.
- ❑ LTA and private training centers deliver training courses for the ADR Drivers and Safety Advisors:
 1. Basic training course
 2. Training course for carriage in tanks
 3. Training course for carriage of substances and articles of Class 1
 4. Training course for carriage of radioactive material of Class 7
 5. Training course for Safety Advisors

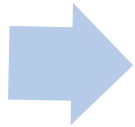

Functions and responsibilities of the authorized bodies

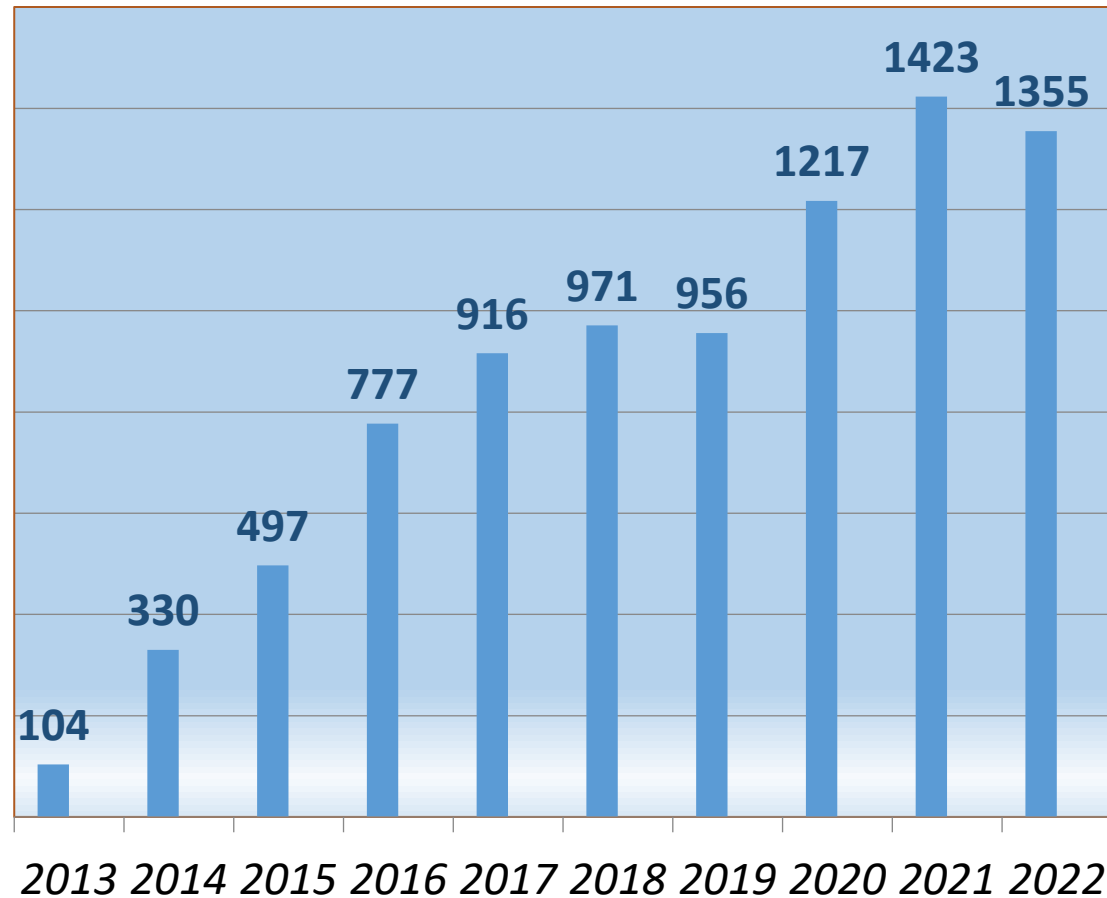

They are checked jointly by the relevant staff of the Land Transport Agency and the National Accreditation Centre.

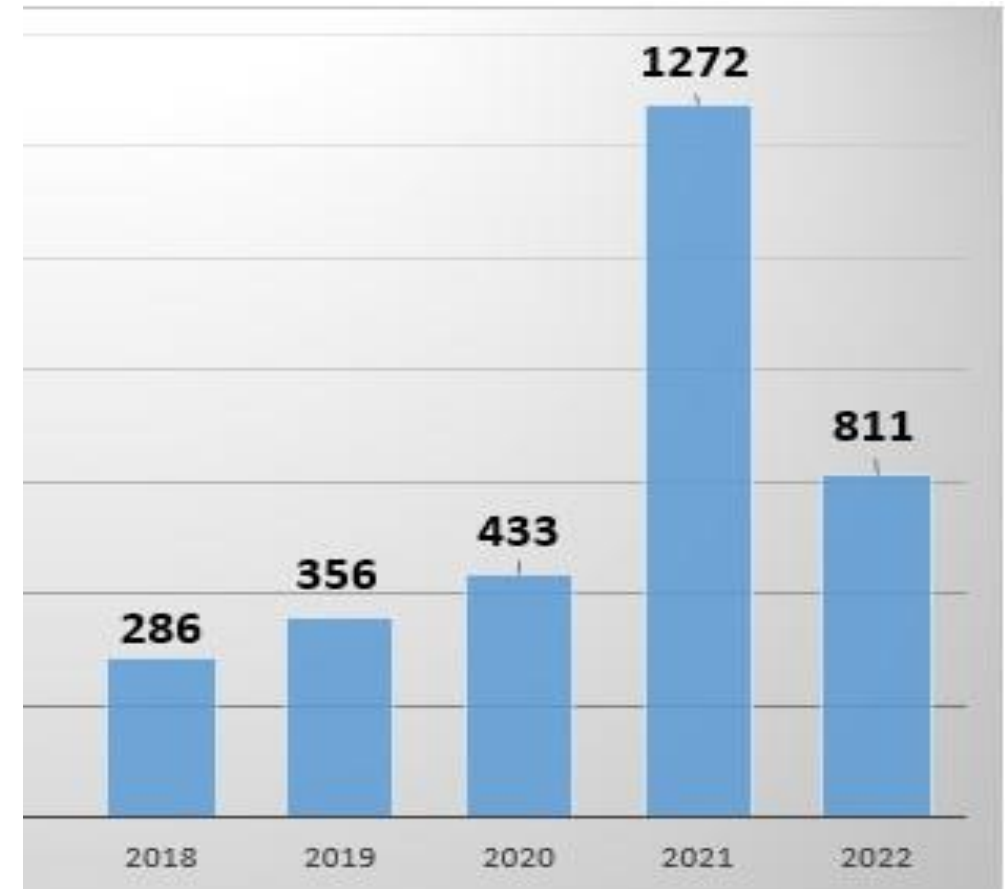

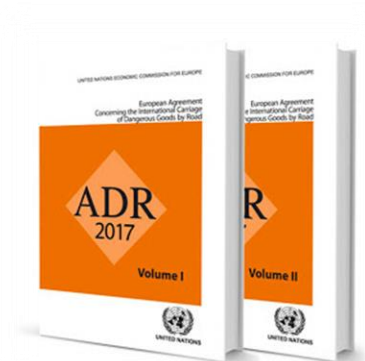

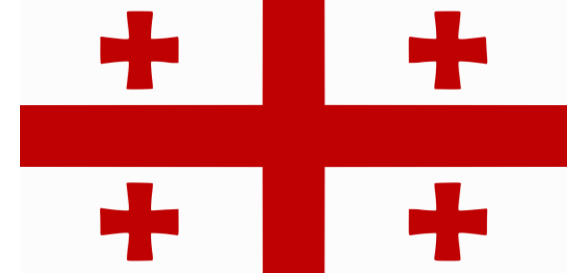

Applicable TDG rules in Railway sector of Georgia



Georgia's accession to COTIF-24.10.2011

Reservations:

- CIV is applicable only on the section from the station Gardabani to the station Kartsakhi, to the state border (244 km), *after this line is put into operation*;
- CIM is applicable only on the following sections of the railway infrastructure of Georgia: a) The section from “Poti” Port- to “Poti” Railway Station-2,7 km; b) The section from “Batumi” Port-to “Batumi” Railway Station-1,9 km; c) section from Gardabani to the station Kartsakhi, to the state border-244 km (*after this line is put into operation*);
- CUV, CUI, APTU, ATMF are not applicable in their entirety.

Other TDG rail regulations in force

- Railway Cooperation Organization (ОСЖД): Annex 2 of the Agreement on International Railway Freight Traffic (CMГC) with the rules for the transportation of classified cargo (three volumes) in **international transportation**;
- Railway Transport Council (ЦСЖТ) Special Rules for the Application of the Agreement on International Rail Freight Traffic (ОП CMГC), Appendix 2-Rules for the Transportation of Dangerous Goods by Rail in **international and national transportation**;
- Railway Code of Georgia and Order #52 of the Minister of Transport and Communications of Georgia "On the rules for transporting hazardous cargo by rail" in **national transportation**.

Directive 2008/68/EC

- RID is translated into Georgian and is under consultations;
- Government of Georgia has initiated the first amendments' package (including the Directive) to the Railway Code of Georgia at the Parliament in February, 2023
