



- 1. Directive 96/53/EC on the maximum authorized dimensions and weights for road vehicles
- 2. Directive 96/6/EEC on the installation and use of speed limitation devices
- **3.** Directive 2003/59/EC on the initial qualification and periodic training of drivers
- 4. Directive 2008/68/EC on the inland transport of dangerous goods
- 5. Directive 2009/40/EC on roadworthiness tests
- **6. Regulation (1071/2009 EC)** establishing common rules concerning the conditions to be complied with to pursue the occupation of road transport operator
- 7. Regulation (EC) 561/2006, Regulation (EEC) 3821/85, Directive 2006/22 EC concerning social legislation relating to road transport
- **8.** Directive 2002/15/EC on the organization of the working time of persons performing mobile road transport activities

Approximation with the EU Legislation

□ Regulation (EEC) 3821/85 is implemented by Governmental Decree N426 On the approval of the technical regulation "Rules for the operation of control devices (tachographs) that record the traffic parameters of motor vehicles"

□ AETR and Regulation (EC) 561/2006 are implemented by Governmental Decree On the approval of the technical regulation "Work and rest regimes of drivers of motor vehicles involved in international transportation"


□Amendment to the technical regulation on the working time of persons involved in road transport activities is in process of elaboration to fully approximate with the provisions of the Directive 2002/15/EC.










Statistical Information






Road Side Check Reform
