


Flag State control & Transport of Dangerous Goods by Sea







Albania has acceded and ratified the Solas and Marpol Conventions which are related and require implementation under the IMDG Code. Therefore, we apply the IMDG Code and comply with all the rules according to this code.

The laws we apply, referring to the Conventions above, are:

- Law no. 9594, dated 27/07/2006, "On the accession of the Republic of Albania to the International Maritime Convention for " The prevention of pollution from ships, 1973", amended by the Protocol of 1978 (MARPOL 73/78"), specifically ANNEX III;
- Law no. 9213, dated 1.4.2004, "On the accession of the Republic of Albania to the International Maritime Convention for "Safety of life at sea (SOLAS), 1947", amended and in the protocol of this convention, of 1978";

- Increased performance in inspections of ports that process dangerous goods.
