The Secretariat seeks to conclude a service contract aimed at assisting the six South East European Parties of the Transport Community to align with relevant EU acquis, consultant will, among other, examine the problems hindering development of multimodality (e.g infrastructure, policy, digitalization issues), conduct a market and prospective analysis on multimodal freight terminals and elaborate an action plan for the development of a multimodal freight terminal network. For carrying out the services, the Contractor's core team may have to be physically present in Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo*, Montenegro, North Macedonia and Serbia.
