WB regional RS Action plan

- Serbia has already implemented almost all measures from Regional Road Safety Action plan.
- Established National Road Safety Coordination Body
- Established **RTSA** in 2009 by the Government and is in operation since 2010.
- Procedure of adoption of **RS Strategy 2023-2030** and three year AP is ongoing.



WB regional RS Action plan

- Quality of systematic and consolidated data collection on road traffic deaths and serious road injuries (CARE data model): Serbia is the first TCT contracting party which is included in pilot project CARE data base.
- <u>KPI</u> have been measured on a yearly basis from 2013 based on Safety-net methodology. In 2022 the methodology was harmonized with the updated EU methodology.


WB regional RS Action plan

- Developed **specific programme for vulnerable road users** - RTSA conducts safe driving trainings for bicycle drivers and motorcycle drivers which has been conducted since 2017, while safe driving trainings for moped drivers have been conducted since 2018).

Road Safety Projects

1. IPA 2016 – EU FOR SERBIA IMPROVING ROAD SAFETY

- Project started in August 2019; 2,5 mil EUR; 24/45 months
- 3 main components:
 - a) establishment of road safety sistem in local community (developement of road safety database, trainings...)
 - b) establishment of MAIS+3 scale of injures in traffic accident and electronic exchange of data
 - c) implementation of road safety tools

2. ROAD REHABILTATION AND SAFETY PROJECTS — 390 mil. EUR; WB, EIB, EBRD, R.Serbia)

- works on rehabilitation on 1100 km of SR (465 km rehabilitated, rehabilitation of 200 km is ongoing) RSA*
- RSI for an additional 1000 km of SR with implementation of low cost road safety measures

3. REGIONAL TRANSPORT AND TRADE FACILITATION PROJECT (WB) – 40 mil E

- ITS on Coridor X
- level crossing
