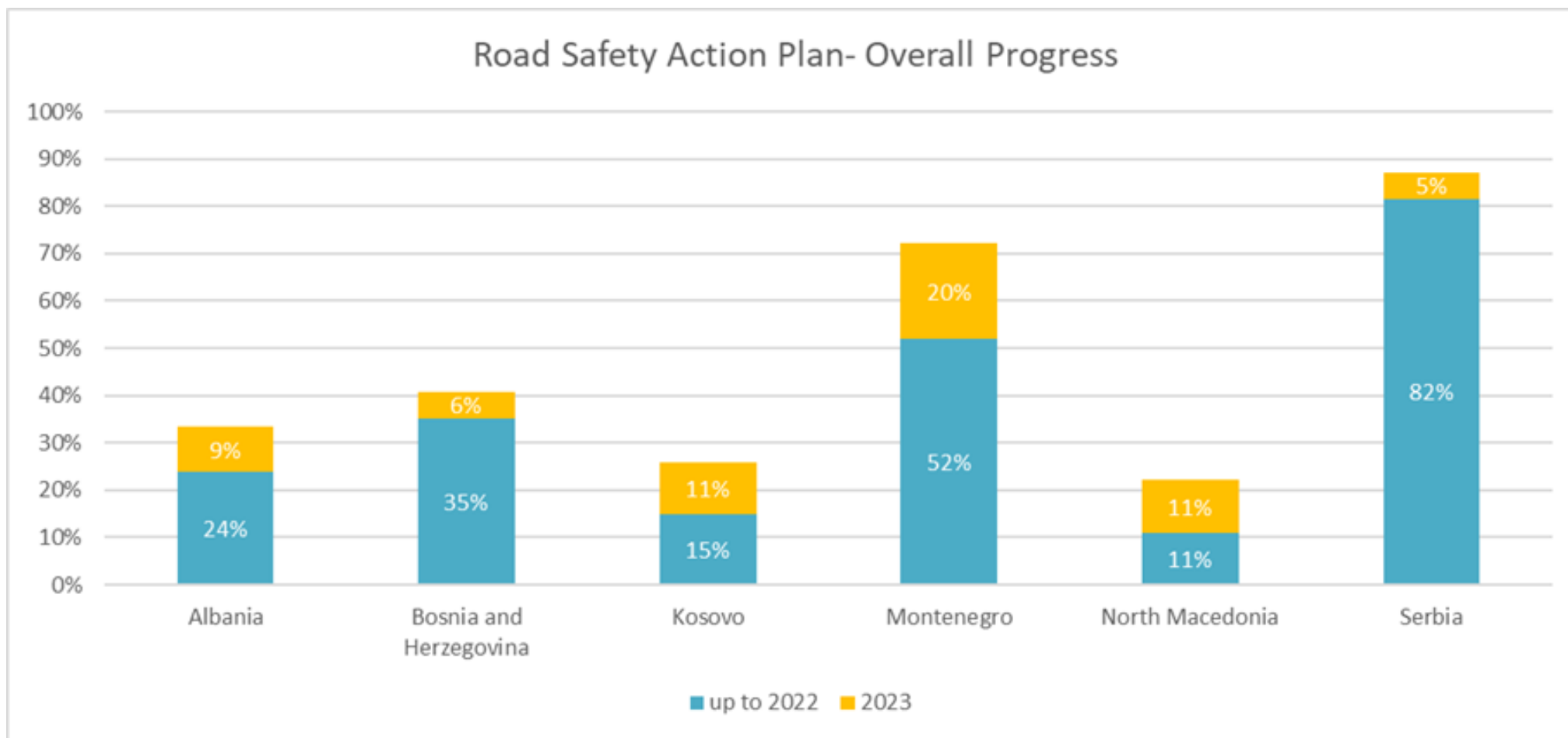

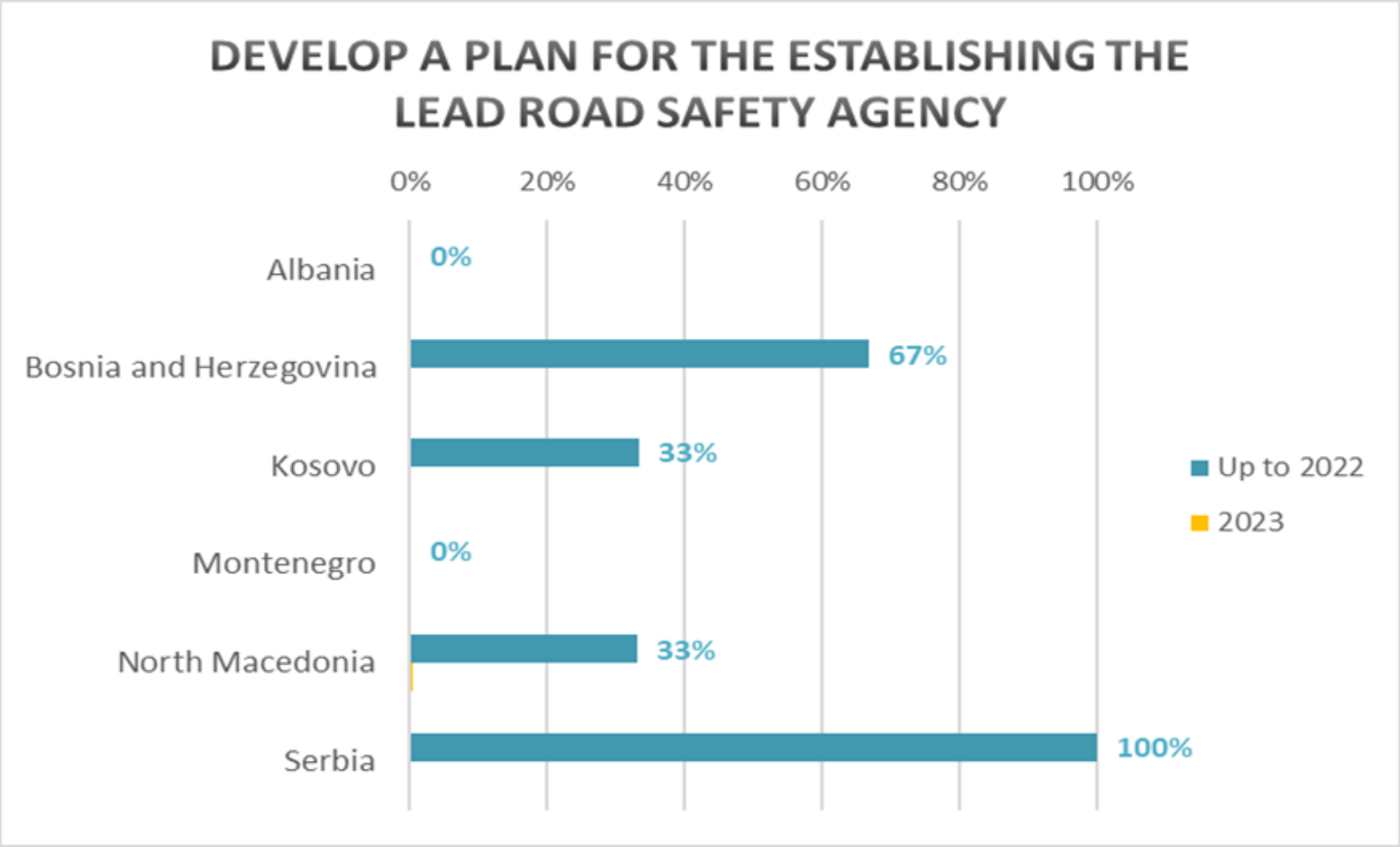

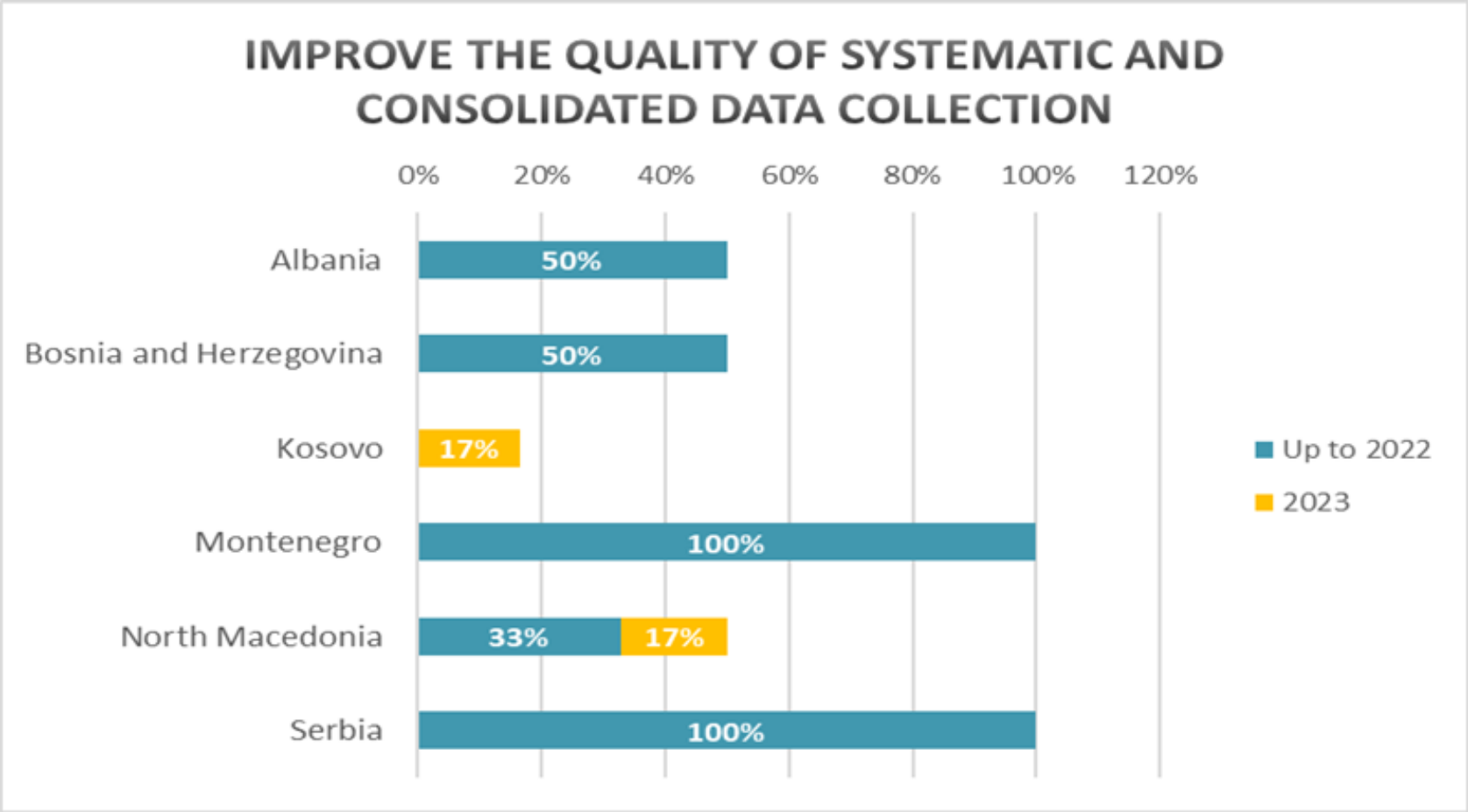
Overall Progress in chart



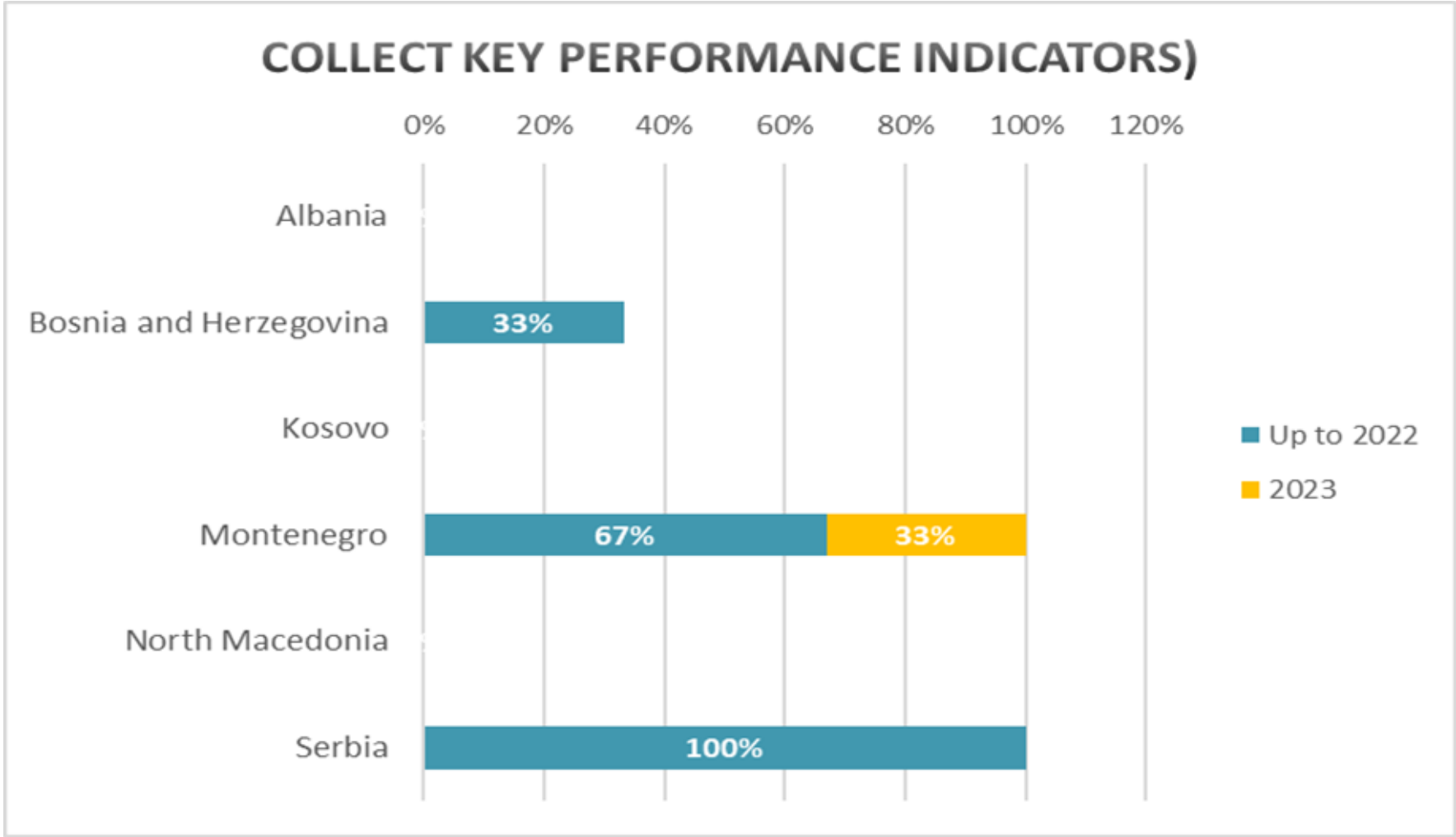

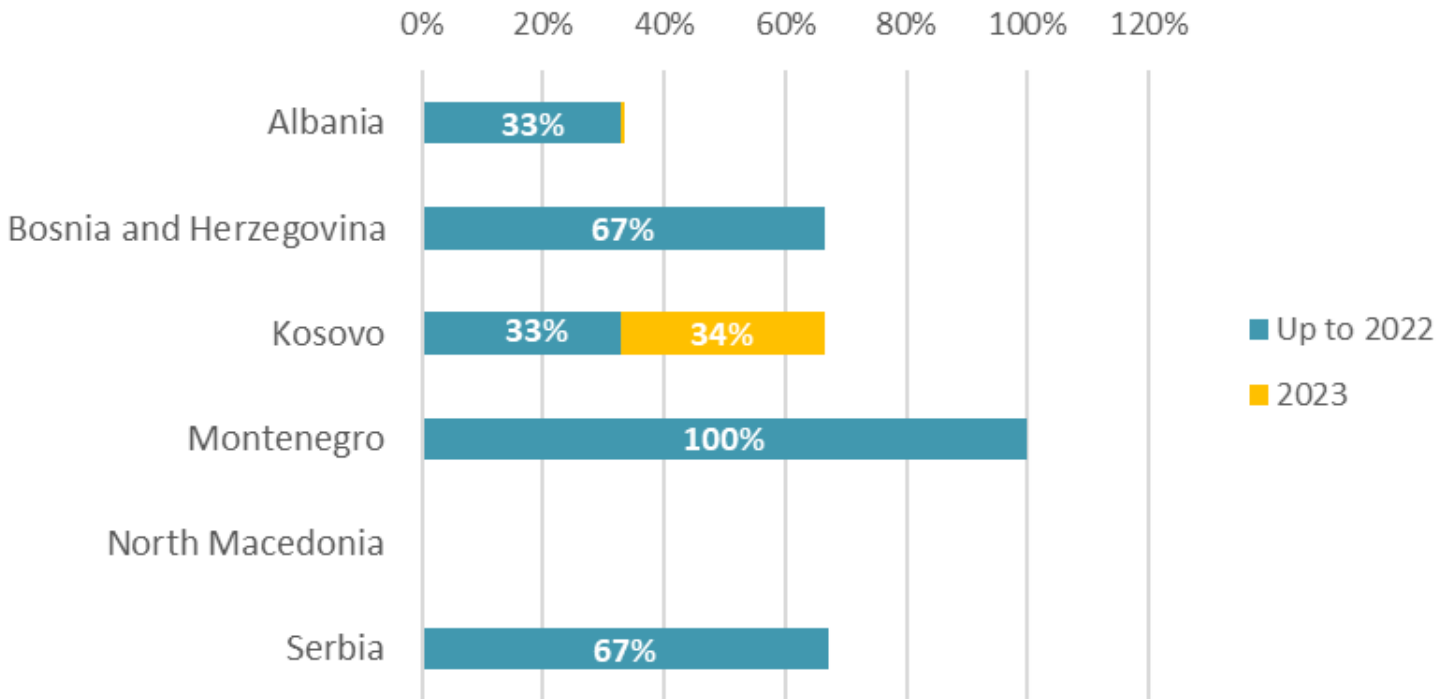

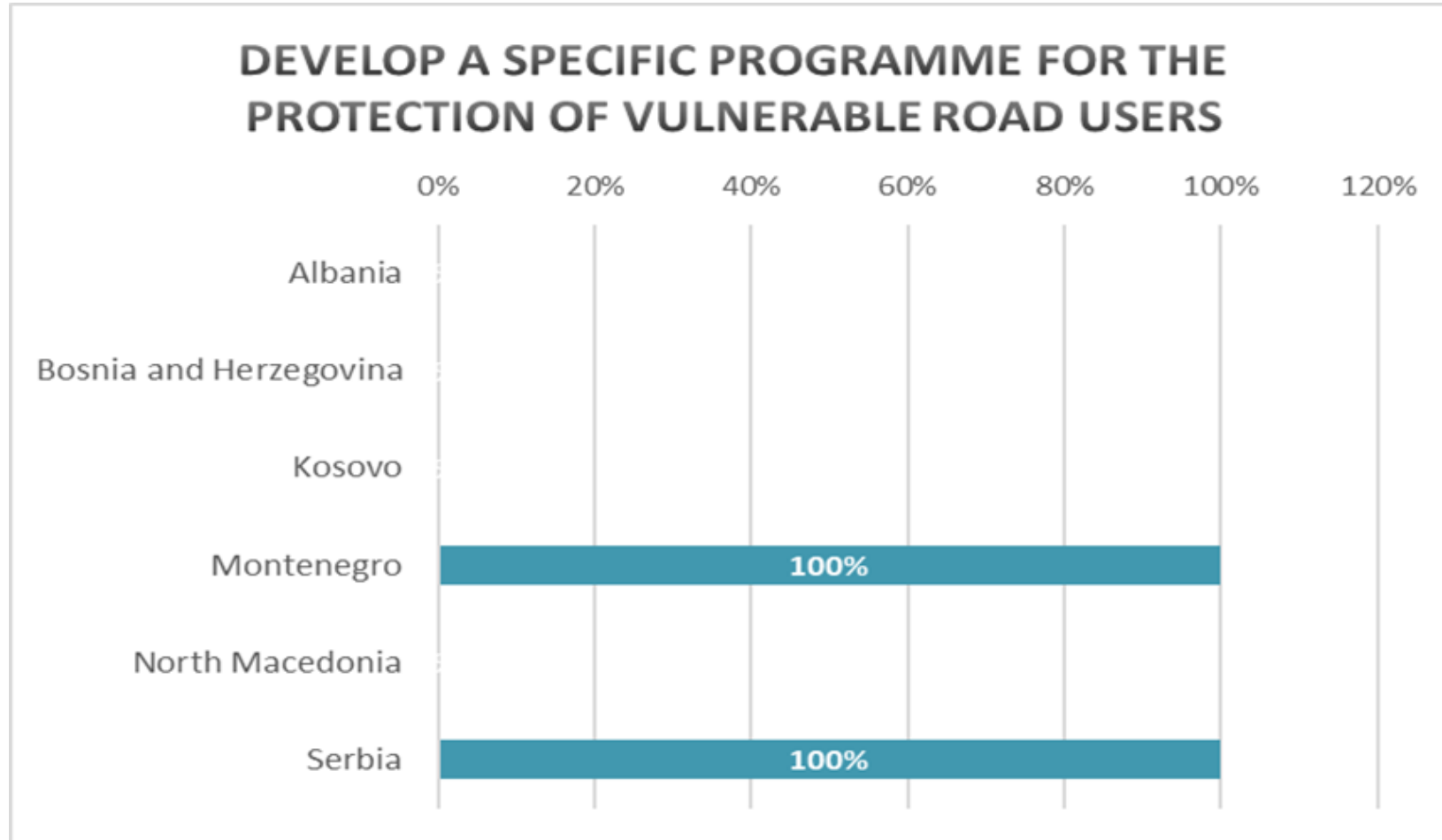
