








Umrli 2013-2022 5-letna drseča povprečja






RESOLUTION OBJECTIVES

In the year 2030, no more than 50 people should die in traffic accidents on slovenian roads.

In the year 2030, no more than 400 persons should be seriously injured in traffic accidents on slovenian roads.







Based on expert input and with the help of all stakeholders, we identified nine pillars of the resolution, including both global and national pillars.

The five global pillars include:

- More modal options and space planning,
- Safe road infrastructure,
- Safe vehicles,
- Safety of road users and
- Post-accident response.

The national pillars, recognized as key areas in Slovenia on which we must focus our efforts for improving traffic safety, are:

- New forms of micromobility,
- Professional drivers of commercial vehicles,
- Drivers of single-track motor vehicles and
- Older participants in traffic.
