DECISION No 2025/01

OF THE REGIONAL STEERING COMMITTEE OF THE TRANSPORT COMMUNITY

on the revision of Annex I to the Treaty establishing the Transport Community

THE REGIONAL STEERING COMMITTEE OF THE TRANSPORT COMMUNITY,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the Transport Community, and in particular Article 20(3), point (a) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) In accordance with Article 20(3), point (a) of the Treaty establishing the Transport Community ('TCT'), in respect of new legally binding European Union acts, the Regional Steering Committee of the Transport Community is to adopt, *inter alia*, decisions revising Annex I to the TCT to integrate those acts in the TCT.
- (2) Since the date of the TCT signature, Annex I has already been updated three times, on 28 June 2021¹, 14 November 2022² and 3 April 2024³. Since these updates, a number of new legal acts of the European Union has been adopted in areas covered by the TCT, whereas other legal acts have been repealed. Annex I should therefore be revised to reflect these changes.
- (3) In addition, for reasons of clarity and legal certainty, Annex I to the TCT should also be revised so as to expressly include the modifications to the legal acts covered.
- (4) For the sake of legal clarity and simplification, it is appropriate to replace Annex I to the TCT by the text in the Annex to this Decision.

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

Annex I to the TCT is replaced by the text in the Annex to this Decision.

Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on date of signature.
