

## INVITATION TO TENDER

**Assignment name: TCT Support in establishing of the Traffic Safety Improvement Coordination Body for Montenegro**

**Reference: PS/SRV/LCE/034/2025**

### Section 1. Introductory information

#### 1.1 Background information on the Permanent Secretariat of the Transport Community

The European Union - in accordance with Council Decision (EU) 2017/1937 - and the Republic of Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo\*, Montenegro, the Republic of North Macedonia, and the Republic of Serbia ('the Contracting Parties') signed the Treaty establishing the Transport Community ('the TCT').

The aim of the TCT is the creation of a Transport Community in the field of road, rail, inland waterway and maritime transport, as well as the development of the transport network between the European Union and the South-East European Parties (hereinafter referred to as 'the Transport Community'). The Transport Community shall be based on the progressive integration of transport markets of the South-East European Parties into the European Union transport market on the basis of the relevant acquis, including in the areas of technical standards, interoperability, safety, security, traffic management, social policy, public procurement and environment, for all modes of transport excluding air transport.

In order to implement the TCT provisions and make the Transport Community operational, a Permanent Secretariat (hereinafter 'the TCT Secretariat') has been established. The seat of the TCT Secretariat is in Belgrade, as defined by the Agreement between the Transport Community and the Republic of Serbia signed on 30 January 2019.

\*This designation is without prejudice to positions on status and is in line with UNSCR 1244 and the ICJ opinion on Kosovo Declaration of Independence.



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## 1.2 Objective of this procurement

The Ministry of Transport of Montenegro requested assistance from the TCT Permanent Secretariat to engage one locally contracted expert to help in the establishment of the National Traffic Safety Improvement Coordination Body for Montenegro based on the Action Plan 2024-2025 of the Road Traffic Safety Improvement Strategy 2024-2030 for Montenegro, and to give some suggestions needed for the establishment of local Traffic Safety Improvement Coordination Bodies in Montenegro. For the purpose of the procurement procedure, one tendering call for the requested expert is published by the TCT Secretariat.

TCT Secretariat seeks to engage a road traffic safety expert to assist the Ministry of Transport of Montenegro to establish the National Traffic Safety Improvement Coordination Body for Montenegro till the fourth quarter of 2025, in order to improve strategic planning and monitoring related to the road traffic safety issues following the EU transport policies, standards and best practices and the Transport community's next generation action plans.

1.3 Expected deliverables of the assignment are: as per the Terms of Reference.

1.4 Tentative timeframe: The assignment is expected to be performed during September 2025 – October 2025.

## Section 2. Language of the supporting documentation

2.1 Language of application: The supporting documentation shall be prepared in English.

## Section 3. Submission of the supporting documentation

3.1 Interested candidates are invited to submit a proposal consisting of the following documentation:

- CVs of experts with relevant experience in all fields related to this tender;
- Statement of Commitment from the expert (commitment letter) attached to this document;
- A short, detailed methodology/proposal on how the assignment will be delivered that will become part of the contract;
- Legal Entity File - attached to this document;
- Financial offer (which shall specify a total sum amount in euros) in a separate document (not part of the CVs, Methodology or the other supporting documentation). Financial offer is sent in a separate email, indicating in the subject line the reference number of the procurement.

Late submissions will not be considered for evaluation. 4.1 The offer will be evaluated against the required criteria as defined in the Terms of Reference.
