Locally contracted expert –To support the Transport Demand Modelling and Network Analysis in Kosovo*

Section 1. Introductory information

1.1 Background information on the Permanent Secretariat of the Transport Community

The European Union - in accordance with Council Decision (EU) 2017/1937 - and the Republic of Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo*, Montenegro, the Republic of North Macedonia, and the Republic of Serbia ('the Contracting Parties') signed the Treaty establishing the Transport Community ('the TCT').

The aim of the TCT is the creation of a Transport Community in the field of road, rail, inland waterway and maritime transport, as well as the development of the transport network between the European Union and the South-East European Parties (hereinafter referred to as 'the Transport Community'). The Transport Community shall be based on the progressive integration of transport markets of the South-East European Parties into the European Union transport market on the basis of the relevant acquis, including in the areas of technical standards, interoperability, safety, security, traffic management, social policy, public procurement and environment, for all modes of transport excluding air transport.

In order to implement the TCT provisions and make the Transport Community operational, a Permanent Secretariat (hereinafter 'the TCT Secretariat') has been established. The seat of the TCT Secretariat is in Belgrade, as defined by the Agreement between the Transport Community and the Republic of Serbia signed on 30 January 2019.

1.2 Objective of this procurement

The assignment aims to strengthen MoIT's capacity for evidence-based transport planning and infrastructure management through the review, updating and enhancement of the existing transport demand model.

The assignment will provide an improved analytical basis for assessing transport demand, analysing network performance, forecasting future traffic conditions and supporting infrastructure investment prioritisation, with particular attention to the indicative TEN-T network and key national and regional corridors.

Furthermore, it will also assess how outputs from the updated transport demand model can support the future development and operationalisation of a Road Asset Management System (RAMS), particularly through the provision of reliable traffic volumes, vehicle composition information and traffic growth forecasts.

The specific objectives of the assignment are to:

- review and assess the existing transport demand model and supporting datasets;
- update and enhance the model to reflect current transport demand patterns, network conditions and recent infrastructure developments;
- assess current transport demand and network performance on key national and indicative TEN-T corridors;
- develop traffic demand forecasts under selected scenarios;
- provide analytical inputs to support transport planning and infrastructure investment prioritisation;
- assess how transport demand modelling outputs can support future RAMS development, maintenance planning and infrastructure management;
- provide recommendations for the future use, maintenance and further development of the transport demand model; and
- transfer to MoIT an updated, documented and operational transport demand model, including all relevant files, assumptions, input data and technical documentation developed under the assignment.

1.3 Expected deliverables of the assignment are: as per the Terms of Reference.

1.4 Tentative timeframe: The assignment is expected to be performed during October 2026 – December 2026.

Financial offer is sent in a separate email, indicating in the subject line the reference number of the procurement.

Please note that only one offer per bidder is permitted. Accordingly, the submission of multiple or alternative offers, including offers submitted individually and jointly by the same party, will not be accepted.

3.2 The required documentation should be submitted electronically by e-mail to procurement@transport-community.org by **21 September 2026, 23:59h CET**. Late submissions will not be considered for evaluation.
